The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) Regional Fisheries Office - MIMAROPA, Department of Agriculture intends to apply the sum of **FOURTEEN MILLION TWO HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND (Php 14,240,000.00) PESOS** being the ABC to payments under the contract for Bid Reference No.: 2023-013 entitled "**SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF EIGHTY-NINE (89) UNITS OF SEAWEED NURSERIES**". 2. BFAR-MIMAROPA now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening. Delivery of the Goods shall be made in accordance with the terms specified in Section VI (Schedule of Requirements). Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
4. Prospective bidders may obtain further information through MR. DEEJAY A. LABIAGA, BAC Secretariat Head of the BFAR MIMAROPA BAC OFFICE, at Telephone No. (043) 288-6322 and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM only, during Mondays thru Fridays.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders from the given address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, **until May 22, 2023; 8:30 AM.**
6. The BFAR-MIMAROPA will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference on May 10, 2023; 10:00 AM** at the address given below and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting via Google Meet. Participants as well as qualified bidders shall be notified of the link by the BAC Secretariat.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below, **on or before May 22, 2023; 1:00 PM. Late bids shall not be accepted.**
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 14.



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9. **Bid opening shall be on May 22, 2023; 1:00 PM** at the given address below and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting via Google Meet. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.
10. The BFAR-MIMAROPA does not condone any form of solicitation on any prospective winning and losing bidders by any of our staff/ employees or any other party. Any sort of this kind shall be reported immediately to the Office of the Secretary or the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) for entrapment and proper investigation.
11. The BFAR-MIMAROPA reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
